INVITATION TO BID (ITB): NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, in accordance with the American Sāmoa Power Authority Procurement Rules §5-103, ASPA will sell at a Public Sealed-Bid Auction the following surveyed vehicles and heavy equipment on Thursday, August 13, 2020 at 10:00AM. All sealed bids must be turned in to the ASPA Procurement Office located at the ASPA Tafuna Compound, Utu Abe Malae Operations Center. All vehicles and equipment will be sold in an “as is – where as” condition, with no warranties or representations, to the highest bidder.

INSPECTION: Vehicles may be inspected at the ASPA Tafuna Auto Shop between 9:00Am to 2:00PM on Thursday, July 30 to Tuesday, August 11, 2020.

BID DEPOSITS: A BID DEPOSIT OF \$200 US DOLLARS IS REQUIRED WITH YOUR BID FOR ANY ONE (1) AUCTIONED VEHICLE. FOR HEAVY EQUIPMENT, A DEPOSIT OF 20 PERCENT OF YOUR BID IS REQUIRED WITH YOUR BID. Bidders must submit bids on the attached “BID FORM” in a sealed envelope or other enclosure addressed to the ASPA Procurement Manager. The sealed envelope or box must be labeled “ASPA Public Sealed-Bid Auction, ITB No. ASPA20.034.FSM-WTR Surveyed Vehicles & Heavy Equipment Auction”. An original and



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two (2) copies must be received at the ASPA Procurement Office no later than 10:00AM local time on August 13, 2020. Late submittals will not be opened or considered and will be designated as non-responsive.

No oral, telephonic, email or facsimile proposals will be considered. No late proposals will be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read on August 13, 2020 at the closing time of 10:00AM. All vehicles and equipment will be sold on an "as is, where is" condition, with no warranties or representations, to the highest bidder. Procedures as listed below shall be applied to all the bidders submitting a bid:

1. All vehicles and heavy equipment will be sold on an "as is, where is" condition. No other exception.
2. All Sales are final.
3. All vehicles and heavy equipment will be sold to the highest bidder.
4. The winning highest bidder is given up until 4:00PM August 14, 2020 to pay for his/her vehicle or heavy equipment.
5. The winning highest bidder shall pay for his/her vehicle or heavy equipment to the ASPA Customer Service and submit his/her receipt to the ASPA Procurement Office.
6. Vehicles purchased from ASPA are to be removed from ASPA's Tafuna compound within the same day of bid opening date unless permission by the ASPA Procurement Office is otherwise given.
7. If the winning highest bidder fails to pay his/her vehicle on the day designated to make payment on, then the vehicle/equipment will be awarded to the 2nd highest bidder.
8. The 2nd highest bidder will then follow steps 1-7. If the 2nd winner does not follow through on his payment as detailed above, the deposit will not be refunded. ASPA will keep the deposit and the vehicle/equipment will then be awarded to the next highest bidder. These procedures will be continued until the vehicle/equipment is sold.
9. **EQUAL BIDS.** In the rare case when two or more low bids are equal in all respects, the award will be decided by drawing lots or other random means of selection.

- Request additional information from any bidder
- Select a bidder for award based on meeting terms, conditions and required specification in this ITB

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EXHIBIT B – D&B HANJIN 35-MULTI DRILLING RIG SPECIFICATIONS

DESCRIPTION

- The American Sāmoa Power Authority will be auctioning a D&B HANJIN 35-MULIT DRILLING RIG
- This drill rig has been used by ASPA recently to drill some of its newest groundwater wells
- The drill rig has 221 working hours and is track mounted with jack legs, has a wireline S/S ¼" (6mm) 1200m reel; reverse circulation capabilities, and a Hanjin rod loading system which can be hydraulically operated from the drillers control panel; a water pump and water injection pump (see Attachment A).
- The drill rig will also come with PWL drill rods and HWL drills rods (core retrieval system) (see Attachment B). Reverse circulation rods are also included (see Attachment C).
